Dear Troop 113 Parents,

Troop 113 had a great year in 2021-2022 and the 2022-2023 year is off to a Great Start!

At this time, we need to get all of our Scouts Registered for the 2022-2023 Scouting Season. The registration deadline is **November 1, 2022**.

The cost breakdown is as follows:

- **New Scout Fee** - \$25 (**Paid Only by Scouts Registering for the first time**)
- **Our Troop Fee** - \$75
- **Council Fee** - \$40/yr. covers administrative costs BSA National has passed on to Council.
- **National Dues per Scout** - \$75/yr.
- **Boys' Life Subscription (optional)** - \$12/yr.

****Our committee has decided that we WILL NOT be charging for a Fundraising Bond or Driving Bond this year. However, it is VITAL that parents step up and volunteer to transport scouts to and from our outings and trips or we will need to reinstate these bonds in the future!**

****If your Scout is New to the Troop and you recently registered, and paid for, them through BeAScout.org, you still need to fill out this form but must only submit payment for the Troop Fee of \$75.**

2023 BSA Summer Camp

Troop 113 has reserved Week 2 (Sunday 7/16/23 to Saturday 7/22/23)
at Winnebago Scout Reservation (www.camp-winnebago.org/home)
for the 2023 BSA Sleep Away Summer Camp.

As it has been become a Troop tradition, we have once again reserved the Chippewa Campsite!

The Winnebago Scout Reservation encompasses more than 450 acres of woodland
for camping, hiking, and outdoor adventure. Durham Pond covers 60 acres for
swimming, sailing, boating and amazing bass fishing.

During camp, the Scouts have the opportunity to earn multiple Merit Badges, Experience High
Adventure activities like Ziplining & Rope Courses, participate in Boating, Hiking, Swimming,
Shooting Ranges (Shotgun, Rifle and Archery), and participate in Camp wide competitions like
Dutch Oven Cooking, Water Carnival (Which our Troop has won 3 years running!) and more.

It also is an excellent setting for the Scouts to bond with each other
and with Scouts from all over the region!

We hope to have as many Scouts attend as possible as we plan to participate in as many
Camp wide Competitions as our attendance numbers allow.

The cost for camp is as follows:

Early Discount Price: \$ 590.00 (until Mon 5/1/23)

Regular Price: \$640.00 (after 5/1/23)
